The Janeway Foundation is pleased to inform Operating Engineers, Local 904 the following update on installation of the new Central Fetal Monitoring System, made possible by the tremendous support of your Membership.

The Division Manager for Labour & Delivery, Maternal Fetal Assessment Unit & Specialty Services informed us that the beginning of the project started the week of January 11th.

The installation and operation of this state-of-the-art Central Fetal Monitoring System requires extensive training for all staff involved. The plan and time lines have been finalized and the interdisciplinary roles of the health care team have been identified. The individuals involved in this project include project managers, IT, clinical staff and managers from the Janeway, as well as the hospital sites located in Burin, Carbonear and Clarenville. We are hoping to have the system up and running by June 28th.

Renovations to accommodate the infrastructure in both the case room and 5NB will begin in February. 5NB is the ward in the Health Science Centre where pregnant mothers are cared for.

Burin, Carbonear and Clarenville should be able to access this system after the summer.

The staff at the Janeway, Burin, Carbonear and Clarenville hospitals are so excited to be moving forward with this project. They are so grateful for the kindness of your membership, because without your generosity it's unlikely this project would have materialized.
